- Nonfiction that includes
 - History and cultural commentary, nature, memoirs and narrative journalism, poetry, story-based mental/spiritual health
- Children's, middle-grade, young adult (in great condition)
- Graphic novels and some manga

Titles published within the last 5ish years or modern classics

Purchased from us recently that you're ready to pass along? Sell it back to us! Have two copies of things like *Beloved*, *The Body Keeps the Score* or *Gilead* for some reason? Sell us that second one!

Books We Aren't Likely to Buy from You

- Collectibles/rare books
- Super specific sub-genres that don't fit into our current inventory
 - Think: architecture tomes, old textbooks, travel guides, how-to business or self-help or religious books, ...
- Titles found in a relative's basement and need to be 'gotten rid of' :)
- Tattered, stained, ripped, water damaged and worn-out books

- Books we do not buy must leave with you as we do not have the space to store/manage donation books. We can provide a list of donation locations.
- Our need for used books ebbs and flows by season and space - every buy at every time may be different
- We will make a cash offer on your stack as a whole and retain the right to decline merchandise
- Sellers must be over the age of 18 with a state-issued photo ID
- Seller must be present during appointments
- Donate your books & Storyhouse will donate what we would have paid to one of our nonprofit partners
